GREENS.

Full time mowing is now in operation and as of 25th April winter rules (i.e. lift and place on fairway only) have now been withdrawn. General play is from the mats and play from the white tees is not allowed unless playing a designated club competition. Another polite request please if you are good enough to hit the greens be good enough to repair your pitch mark. And a reminder that the greens staff when they are carrying out their maintenance duties have absolute priority on the course for their safety and also as a compliance with our health and safety policy. The rear of the putting green has now been repaired and boards are available for company advertising. All disturbed ground resulting from the course improvement program including newly sown areas with immature grass growth are to be treated as ground under repair (i.e. nearest point of relief and then one club length not nearer the hole.) A number of members have asked if you drop a ball from shoulder height and then realise your mistake and re drop from knee height is this a penalty.---- you may re drop the ball without penalty but if you drop from shoulder height and play your shot you incur a one shot penalty.
